Arrange to meet with an attending faculty member to review an inpatient note with you while giving you feedback (for PGY1/2 a Progress Note, for PGY3 a Discharge Summary). Submit a copy of the completed Mini-CEX to the Department of Medicine (Gus or Esther).
