

## Follow-up for COVID19 [+] patients discharged from hospital inpatient setting

(with or w/o supplemental home O2\*)

**Empaneled to** non-DHS PCP

F/U phone visit with outside PCP in 1-2 weeks as usual (UM requests OON PCP phone visit) Empaneled to DHS PCP

Phone evaluation within 7 days with DHS PCMH
(UM messages -> OV Care Manager)

Unempaneled

Schedule a follow-up phone visit within 7 days with CCC-PDC (Inpatient Team messages CCC-PDC)

Provider determines post-discharge needs.

If patient needs to be seen in person, provider schedules for FTF\*\* visit

## **Urgent** FTF visit:

Advise patient to seek care at UC/ED or call 911. Patient should wear mask and disclose COVID status.

FTF within 14 days of

discharge:

Schedule in UC-Ext

## **Unempaneled:**

Schedule appointment with CCC-PDC

## **Empaneled:**

Schedule appointment with DHS PCMH

<sup>\*</sup> Patients can be discharged with a home oximeter by ordering "DME Home Oximeter Device" in ORCHID. Instruct patient to use and record values BID at rest, and have values ready for phone visit within 7 days. For patients without home oximeters, a FTF home oxygen evaluation can be done after 14 days.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Face-to-face (FTF) evaluation indicated for physical exam for comorbidity (e.g., volume check), +/- pulse ox check (to d/c O2), etc. Routine COVID19 f/u should not require FTF visit.
